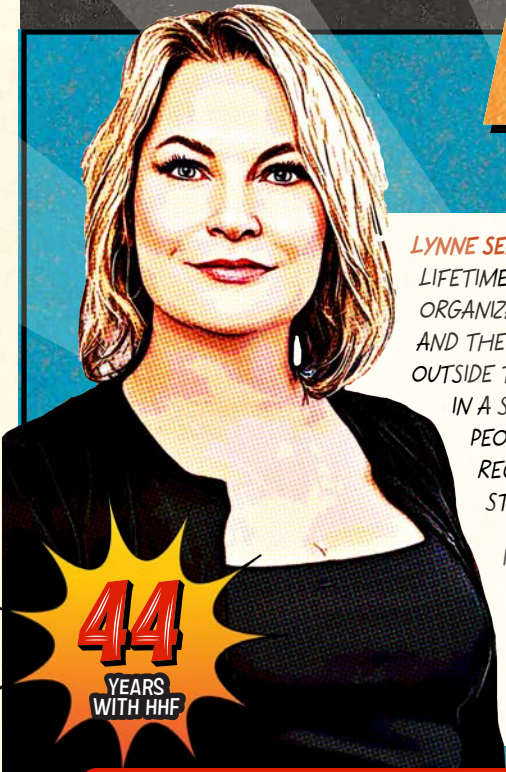

## LYNNE SEAGLE

**HONORED WITH NATIONAL ARC 2021 LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

LYNNE SEAGLE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF HOPE HOUSE FOUNDATION, WAS AWARDED THE OUTSTANDING LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD BY THE ARC IN 2021. THE ARC IS THE LARGEST NATIONAL COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION ADVOCATING FOR AND WITH PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND THEIR FAMILIES. THE OUTSTANDING LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECOGNIZES AN INDIVIDUAL INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE ARC NETWORK WHO LIVES BY THE CORE VALUES OF THE ARC BY PROVIDING LEADERSHIP RESULTING IN A SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT IN SUPPORTS, SERVICES, OPPORTUNITIES, AND COMMUNITY INCLUSION FOR PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND THEIR FAMILIES. THERE WERE A RECORD NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS FROM ACROSS THE UNITED STATES, BUT SEAGLE'S NOMINATION STOOD OUT AMONG THE REST.

IT IS DOUBTFUL THAT ONE COULD FIND AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS IMPACTED THE DISABILITY FIELD AS DEMONSTRABLY AND FOR AS LONG A PERIOD OF TIME AS LYNNE, WHO JOINED HOPE HOUSE FOUNDATION IN 1978 AND WAS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FROM 1982 TO 2022. INDEED, HAVING BEGUN HER CAREER WITH THE ARC OF NORFOLK IN 1975, IT IS NOT AN EXAGGERATION TO SAY THAT SHE HAS DEVOTED CLOSE TO HALF A CENTURY TO HER PASSION – THE FULL INCLUSION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY OF PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

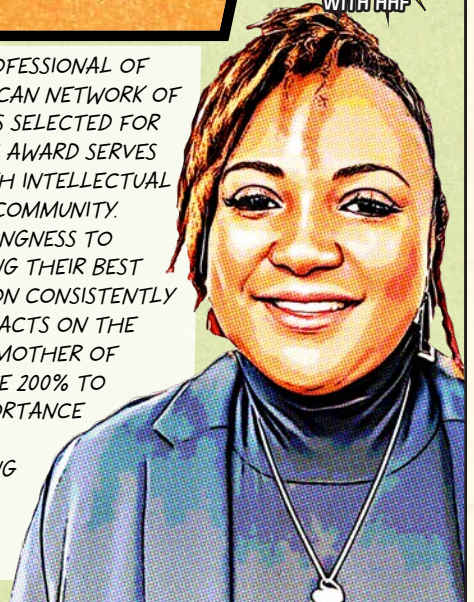

## 2022 DIRECT SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR IN THE RELATIONSHIPS CATEGORY

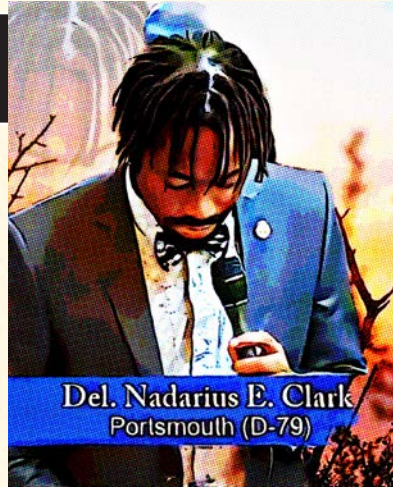

LAKIESHA WAS SELECTED FOR RECOGNITION FROM MORE THAN 300 NOMINATIONS, AND THIS AWARD SERVES AS A TESTAMENT TO HER WORK TO SUPPORT INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES IN THE HAMPTON ROADS COMMUNITY. SHE IS ADMIRER FOR HER KINDNESS, COMMITMENT AND WILLINGNESS TO GO THE EXTRA MILE TO ENSURE THAT INDIVIDUALS ARE LIVING THEIR BEST LIFE. DURING A YEAR OF CRITICAL SHORT STAFFING, JOHNSON CONSISTENTLY VOLUNTEERED TO WORK OVERTIME AND MADE LASTING IMPACTS ON THE LIVES OF PEOPLE SHE SUPPORTS.
